What We're Learning...

Phonics: We will learn to do things with a name, in order to learn it well! We will also focus on the way that names and words can teach us letters and sounds.
Letter spotlight: M

Reader's Workshop: We will begin reader's workshop! We will discuss how to be a "book lover" and 3 ways to read a book: read the words, read the pictures, and retell the story.

Writer's Workshop: We will officially launch our writer's workshop! Writers will learn to think of something that they know about and use pictures and words to put their ideas on paper. We will also learn that "When we are done, we have just begun!"

Math: We will begin math workshop! The theme for this module is "attributes of shoes." Students share what they notice about their shoes, compare what is the same and what is different, and sort shoes and themselves into groups according to their attributes. Students are engaged in practicing one-to-one correspondence and developing the concept of cardinality.

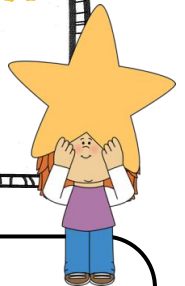
Science: Daily/Seasonal Changes, Sounds
