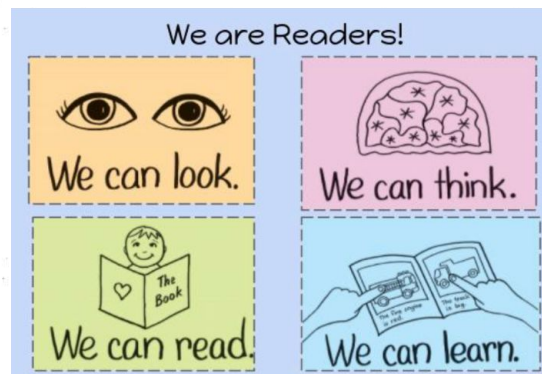

# What We're Learning...

**Phonics:** We will study names to learn more letters and learn that syllables can help readers & writers tackle long words.

Letters spotlight: S, T, N  
Snap Words: color words, I, a, me, the

**Reader's Workshop:** Readers will read the world around them, read books to learn about the world, and learn how to private vs. partner read!

**Writer's Workshop:** Writers will continue to become independent writers and learn to stretch out sounds in words!

**Math:** Mathematicians will learn about the five-frame, which is a tool that provides opportunities for combining quantities in the range of 1-5. They will use it to recognize number of dots and empty boxes, use finger patterns to represent quantities, and build quantities with cubes.
