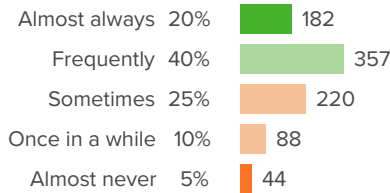

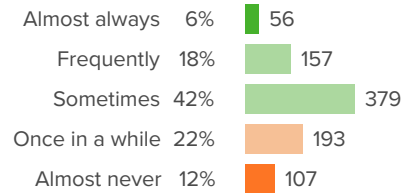
**Q.1: How often do teachers encourage you to learn about people from different races, ethnicities, or cultures?**

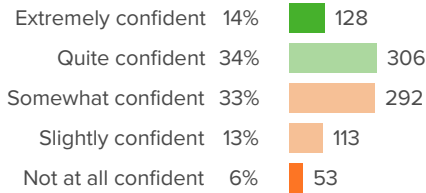
**Q.2: How often do you think about what someone of a different race, ethnicity, or culture experiences?**

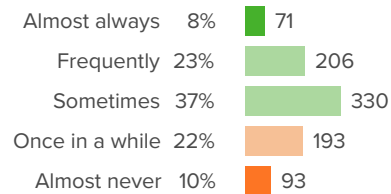
**Q.3: How confident are you that students at your school can have honest conversations with each other about race?**

**Q.4: At your school, how often are you encouraged to think more deeply about race-related topics?**

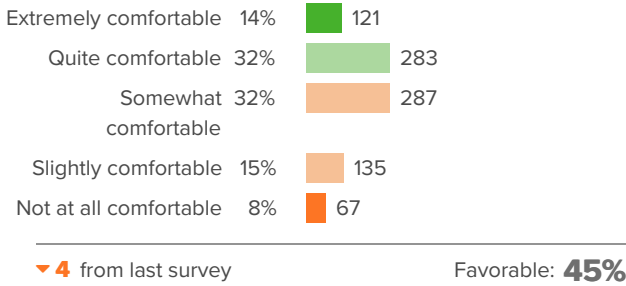

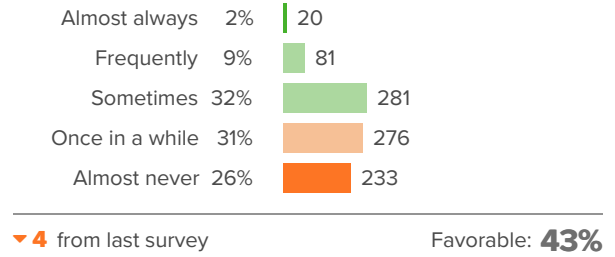

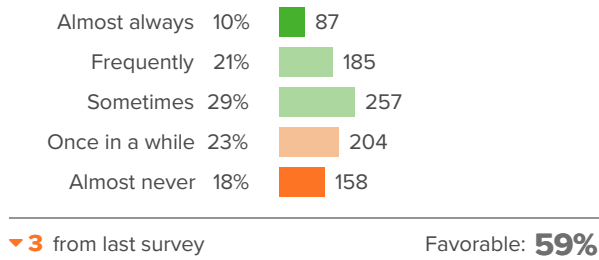
**Q.5: How comfortable are you sharing your thoughts about race-related topics with other students at your school?**



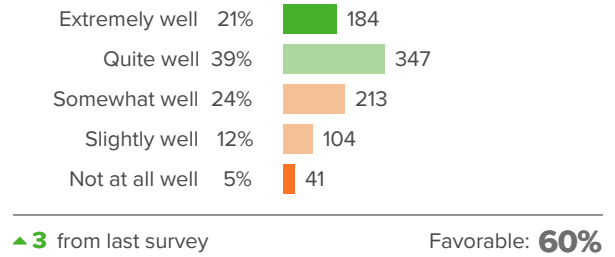
**Q.6: How often do students at your school have important conversations about race, even when they might be uncomfortable?**

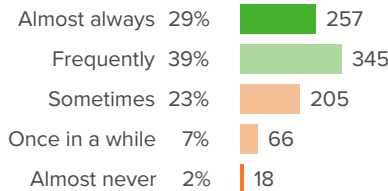

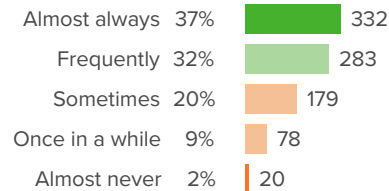

**Q.1: How often do you spend time at school with students from different races, ethnicities, or cultures?**



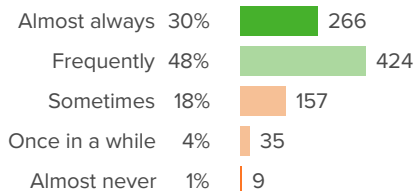

**Q.2: How often do you have classes with students from different racial, ethnic, or cultural backgrounds?**



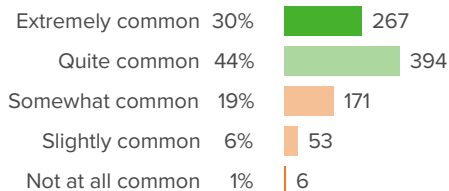

**Q.3: At your school, how often do students from different races, ethnicities, or cultures hang out with each other?**



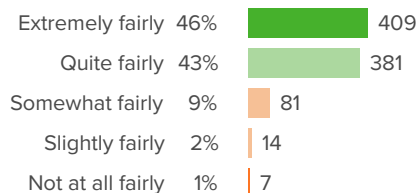

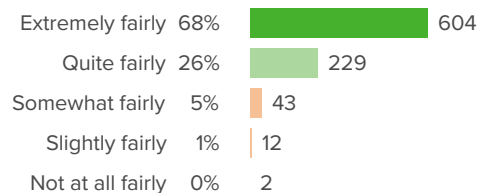

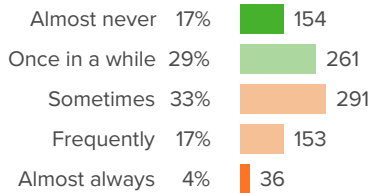

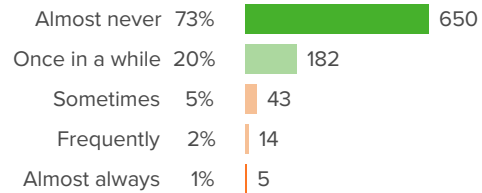
### Q.1: How often are people disrespectful to others at your school?

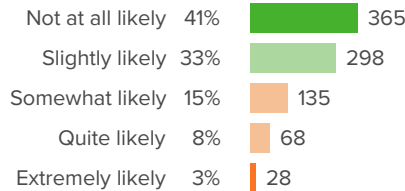
### Q.2: How often do students get into physical fights at your school?

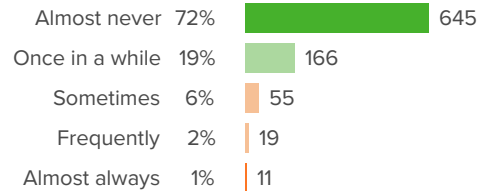
### Q.3: How likely is it that someone from your school will bully you online?

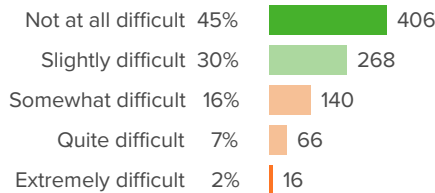

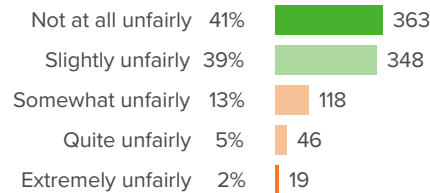
### Q.5: If a student is bullied in school, how difficult is it for him/her to get help from an adult?

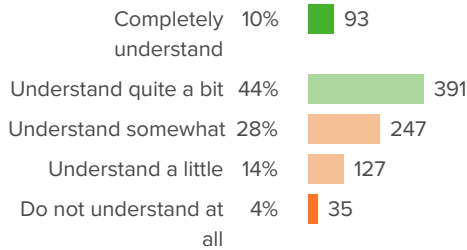

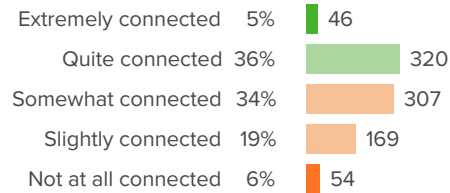
### Q.1: How well do people at your school understand you as a person?

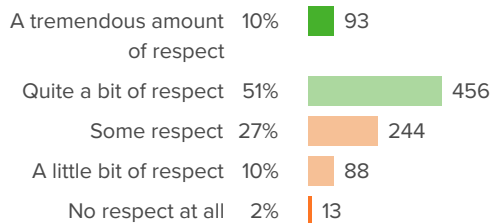
### Q.2: How connected do you feel to the adults at your school?

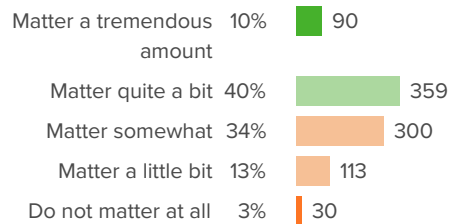
### Q.3: How much respect do students in your school show you?

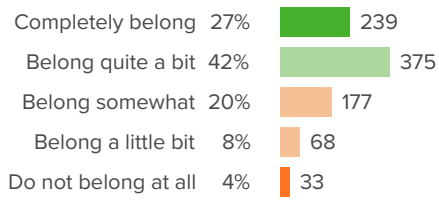

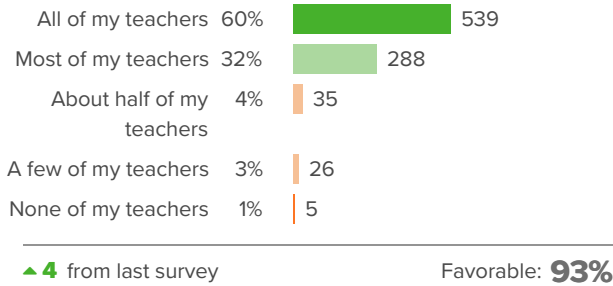

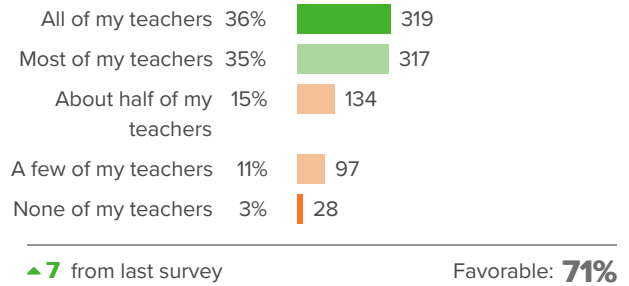

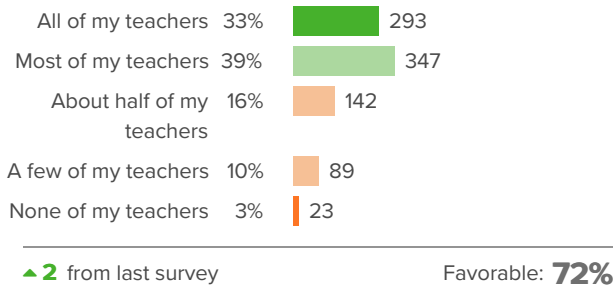
### Q.1: How many of your teachers are respectful towards you?



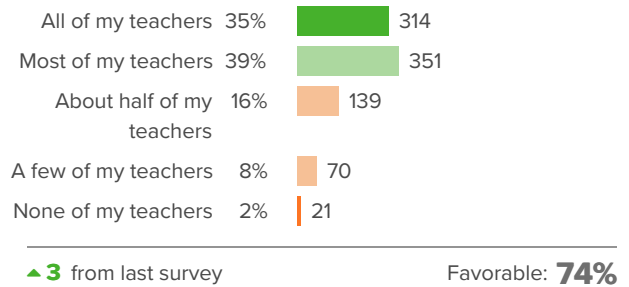
### Q.2: If you walked into class upset, how many of your teachers would be concerned?
