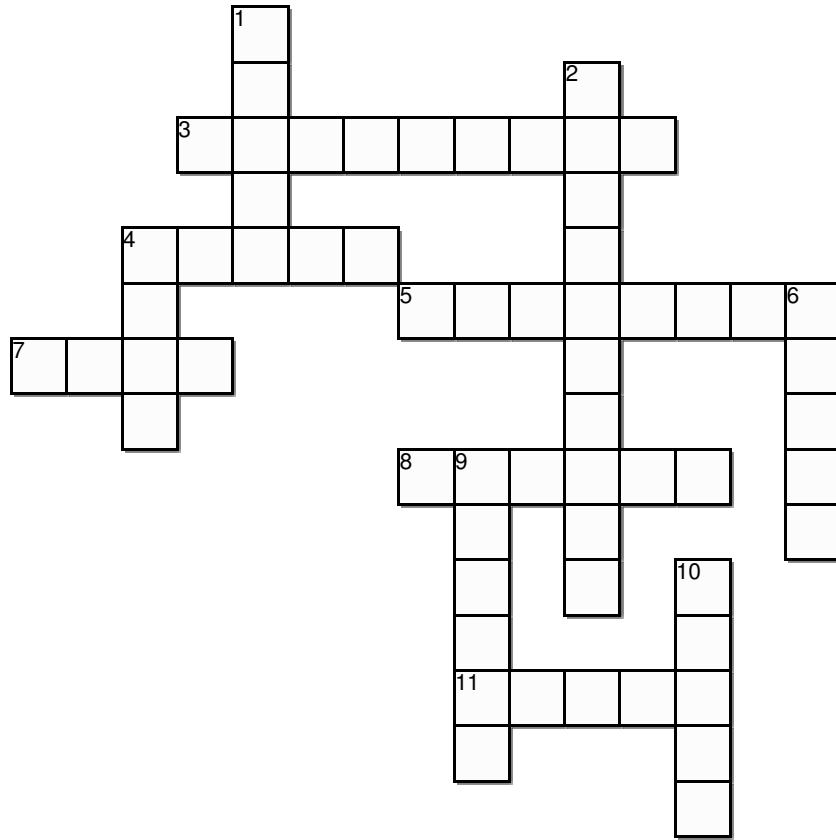

## Across

3. Person responsible for researching the play
4. Off-stage space on the sides where actors and production crew wait to enter the stage or move set pieces
5. Directions as to where actors should move onstage, also known as staging
7. Reading and performing something for the first time, usually done at auditions, is called a '\_\_\_ reading'
8. To remove a prop or set piece from the stage; also known as the process of disassembling the set at the end of a show's run
11. Markings on the stage floor that represent where set pieces, actors, or other items should go

## Down

1. Area on the stage that goes past the proscenium
2. Frame or arch separating the stage from the auditorium
4. When the character speaks directly to and recognizes the audience is called 'breaking the fourth \_\_\_'
6. Lounge where actors hang out before going onstage and during intermission is called the '\_\_\_ room'
9. Type of stage where audience sits on three sides is called a '\_\_\_ stage'
10. Type of theatre where audience sits on all four sides, also known as theatre-in-the-round
