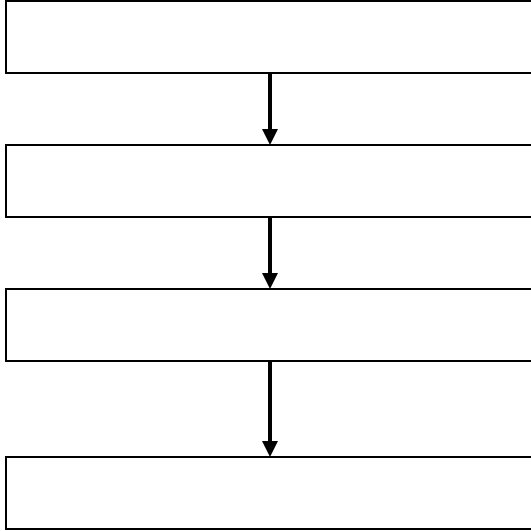
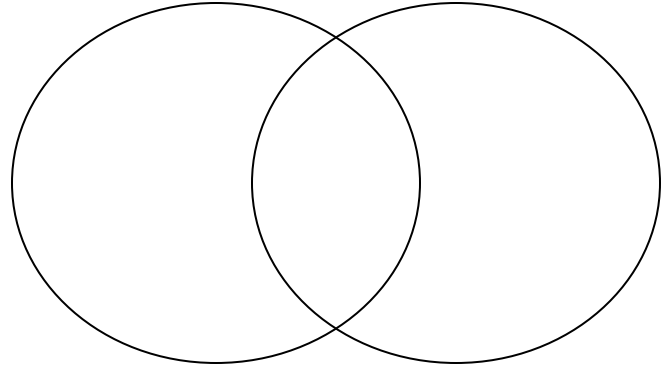


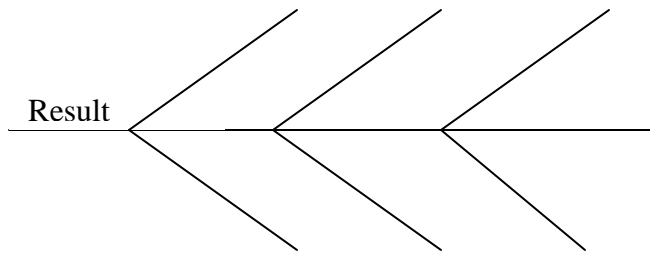
Series of Events: Can be used to show the sequence of events in history.



Venn Diagram: Used to compare similarities and differences. Similarities would be listed in the overlapping area of circles, while differences are put in the non-overlapping area of the circle.



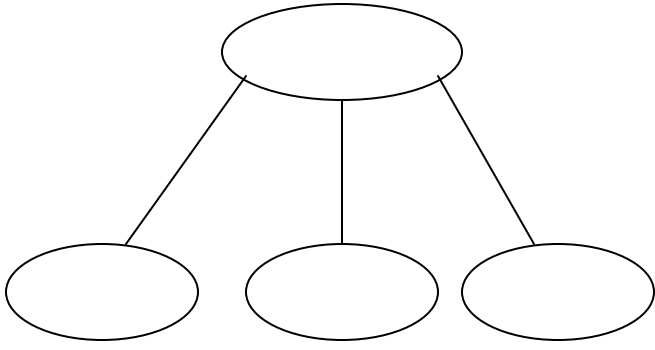
Fishbone Diagram: Ribs identify factors that contribute to the result.



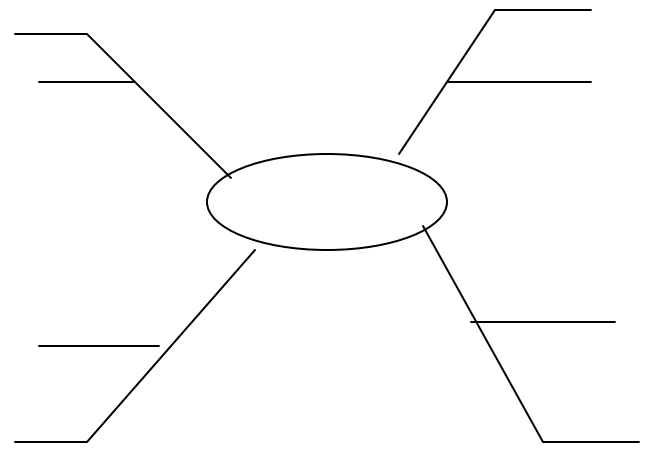
Continuum Scale: Used to portray a timeline, political orientation on a political spectrum, number line or anything that can be represented as a continuum.



The Network Tree: main idea goes at the top, related ideas go below. Can have many levels of connected ideas.



Spider Map: Shows main idea in the middle, related ideas branch from there.



Compare and Contrast Matrix: Can be used to compare or to contrast multiple items.
